What is the overall deductible ?	\$6,850 Individual / \$13,700 Family for Tier 1 - preferred and \$6,850 Individual / \$13,700 Family for Tier 2 - standard in-network services. No coverage out-of-network . Tier 1 preferred deductible applies to Tier 2-standard deductible . In-network deductible will not exceed Tier 2 limit.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the policy, the overall family deductible must be met before the plan begins to pay.
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible ?	Yes. Preventive care , preventive prescriptions and copay services from in-network providers are covered before you meet your deductible .	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost-sharing and before you meet your deductible . Are there other deductibles for specific services?	No.	You don't have to meet deductibles for specific services.
What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan ?	\$7,900 Individual/ \$15,800 Family for Tier 1 - preferred and \$7,900 Individual/ \$15,800 Family for Tier 2 - standard in-network services. There is no coverage out-of-network . Tier 1 preferred out-of-pocket applies to Tier 2-standard out-of-pocket . In-network out-of-pocket will not exceed Tier 2 limit.	The out-of-pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this plan , they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.
What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit ?	Premiums , balance-billing charges, health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit .
Will you pay less if you use a network provider ?	Yes. Visit www.medica.com/insurenetwork or call 800-918-6164 (TTY:711) for a list of network providers .	This plan uses a provider network . You will pay the least if you use a provider in the Tier 1 - preferred network . You will pay more if you use a provider in the Tier 2 - standard network . You will pay the most if you use an out-of-network provider , and you might receive a bill from a provider for the difference between the provider's charge and what your plan pays (balance billing). Be aware, your network provider might use an out-of-network provider for some services (such as lab work). Check with your provider before you get services.
Do you need a referral to see a specialist ?	No.	You can see the specialist you choose without a referral .

Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes.
