Important Questions	Answers	Why This Matters:
What is the overall deductible?	\$850 Individual / \$2,550 Family for Tier 1 - preferred and \$1,500 Individual / \$4,500 Family for Tier 2 - standard network services. There is no coverage for non-network services. Tier 1 preferred deductible applies to Tier 2-standard deductible. Network deductible will not exceed Tier 2 limit.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. Preventive care, preventive prescriptions and copay services from network providers are covered before you meet your deductible.	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. Are there other <u>deductibles</u> for specific services?	No.	You don't have to meet <u>deductibles</u> for specific services.
What is the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> for this <u>plan</u> ?	\$8,100 Individual / \$16,200 Family for Tier 1 - preferred and \$8,700 Individual / \$17,400 Family for Tier 2 - standard network services. There is no coverage for non-network services. Tier 1 preferred out-of-pocket applies to Tier 2-standard out-of-pocket. Network out-of-pocket will not exceed Tier 2 limit.	The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <u>plan</u> , they have to meet their own <u>out-of-pocket limits</u> until the overall family <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> has been met.
